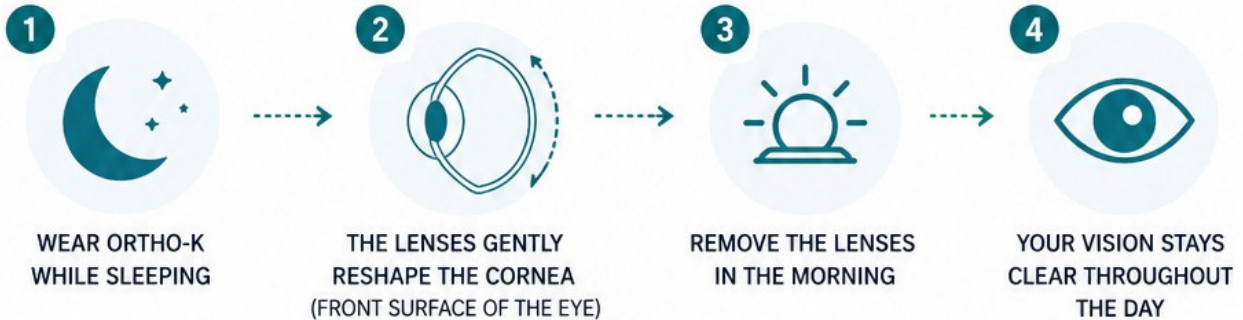
Ortho-K (short for Orthokeratology) is a **non-surgical vision correction** method that uses specially designed hard contact lenses worn overnight to **reshape the cornea** so you can see clearly during the day without glasses or contacts.

The effect is temporary, so you need to wear the lenses regularly (usually every night).

However, if you would like to temporarily switch back to glasses, you would discontinue wearing the contact lenses and restart them when it feels needed.

MILD FARSIGHTEDNESS (HYPEROPIA)



Ortho-K is especially popular for children and younger adults to **slow myopia progression**, as well as adults who do not want daytime lenses or surgery.

BENEFITS



No glasses/contacts during the day



Non-surgical alternative to LASIK



Reversible (stop wearing → cornea returns to normal)



May help slow myopia progression in children

COST



Ortho-K fees include a **\$750** fitting fee and **\$1,200** for the custom lenses in the first year.



If you are not satisfied with the lenses within the first **90 days**, the lens portion of the treatment cost will be refunded.



In year two, the fitting fee is **reduced by 50%** for routine refitting. A full fitting fee applies if a complete refit is required due to significant prescription or eye changes.
